

What is in Ancestry.com that is not in Ancestry Library Edition?

- *One World Tree*
Uses existing family trees to create and expand a tree of your own. It searches over 200 million names in existing family trees and helps you directly contact the people who submitted any trees of interest.
- *Obituary Collection*
Contains recent obituaries from hundreds of newspapers
- *PeopleFinder*
Helps to put users in touch with other researchers looking for the same ancestors.
- *Family Facts*
Self-populating fields on the side of your search results that provide additional facts about your search, such as the most common occupation of people with that name.
- *Historical Newspaper Collection*
Small town newspapers; most do not have complete series / coverage
- *ProQuest's G&LH Books in the Families and Local Histories Collection*
These titles are found in HeritageQuest Online
- *Periodical Source Index (PERSI)*
This database is found in HeritageQuest Online
- *Freedman's Bank Records*
This database is found in HeritageQuest Online
- *Biography & Genealogy Master Index (BGMI)*

- *Passenger and Immigration List Index (PILI)*
