Income Tax Preparation Sites

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program provides free tax preparation assistance with electronic filing for qualified taxpayers by trained, IRS-certified volunteers. They can prepare the following forms:

- 1040A with Schedules 1, 2, 3, & EIC
- 1040 with Schedules A, B, EIC, & R
- 1040EZ, 1040-V, & 1040-ES
- 2441 Child & Dependent Care Credit
- 8863 Education Credits
- 8812 Additional Child Tax Credit
- S.C., N.C., and other state income tax returns
- Other tax credits and forms not listed here

VITA tax assistance will be offered at these local sites:

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide provides free tax preparation help for low-to moderate-income taxpayers, especially those 50 and older. There is no limit on age or income, and AARP membership is not required. Local sites include:

- **Clover Public Library:** 107 Knox St., Clover, SC. Open Tuesdays, 10 a.m.–2 p.m., and Thursdays, 1–5 p.m., Feb. 1–Apr. 18.
- **Fort Mill Public Library:** 1818 Second Baxter Crossing, Fort Mill, SC. Open Thursdays (12:30–6 p.m.) and Fridays (9:30 a.m.–3 p.m.), Feb. 1–Apr. 18, and the following Saturdays (9:30 a.m.–3 p.m.): Feb. 11, Feb. 25, Mar. 4, Mar. 18, and Mar. 25. No returns started within 1½ hours of closing.
- **Chester County Library:** 100 Center St., Chester, SC. Open Tuesdays and Thursdays, Feb. 1–Apr. 18, 9 a.m.–1 p.m. Must sign in by 12 noon. Filing for previous year's taxes not acceptable until March.
- **Lancaster County Council on Aging:** 309 S. Plantation Rd., Lancaster, SC. Open Mondays and Wednesdays, 1–5 p.m., Feb. 1–Apr. 18. Must sign in by 4 p.m.

What to Take with You

- Current tax forms, W-2 and 1099s
- Information regarding other income
- Information for all deductions/credits
- Copy of last year's tax return
- Proof of account for direct deposit of refund (e.g., voided check)
- Social security or individual taxpayer identification cards for yourself, your spouse, and/or dependents
- Proof of ID for yourself and/or spouse
